

## ***Call for proposals: The 2024 PPTG Student Research Grant!***

### **The Perception and Performance Tech Group invites proposals for the 2024 PPTG Student Research Grant**

#### **What is this?**

A small grant to support HFES Student Members conducting independent research related to perception and performance.

#### **How many awards will be made?**

1–2

#### **Who is eligible?**

Any student member of the Human Factors and Ergonomics Society.

#### **How much can be requested?**

Each award will be up to \$500

#### **What can the money be used for?**

Expenses related to conducting the proposed research, e.g., buying research equipment or materials, paying research participants, etc. Part of the awarded money can be put toward the fee for joining the PPTG.

#### **How do I apply?**

Please send the following materials as a single PDF to PPTG Chair Ellemieke van Doorn ([ellemieke.vandoorn@ns.nl](mailto:ellemieke.vandoorn@ns.nl)) by April 1st, 2024.

1. A structured proposal, including the following sections:

- Background and objectives
- Project description
- A transparency & open science statement explaining A) whether and how research methods will be preregistered, and B) whether and how materials, scripts, and/or data generated by the research will be shared.
- A budget and justification specifying how awarded funds will be used
- Cited references

The proposal should be no longer than 3 pages (double-spaced, 1-inch margins, 12-point font), *excluding* the budget, budget justification, and references. Proposals that do not adhere these content and formatting requirements will not receive consideration.

2) A signed letter of support (one page max) from the student's advisor.

#### **What happens if I receive the funding?**

Grant awardees are expected to inform the technical group of their research outcomes by submitting a research paper to the annual meeting of the following year. If the student cannot attend the annual meeting, a report to the TG chair is expected in place

of a paper. The student awardee, or their advisor, should also present the research proposal during the PPTG business meeting, which typically occurs during the annual ASPIRE (HFES) meeting. Membership of the Performance and Perception Technical Group is not required at the time of application but is expected upon receipt of the award.
